Anderson, CA – Sierra Pacific Industries (SPI) announced today that it will re-start its biomass electrical power plant located in Loyalton, CA. The plant closed on September 12th due to poor economic conditions, resulting in the layoff of 19 employees.

"SPI has resolved contractual issues with its power purchaser allowing the plant to begin operations in early January" said plant manager Jim Turner. "We will be bringing more fuel to the plant and will make an effort to call employees back to work who were terminated" added Turner.
